Application Instructions

Requirements:

- ✓ You **must** be a member of the Polish National Catholic Church and assist actively in the musical life of the Polish National Catholic Church.
- ✓ You **must** be taking paid music lessons or attending paid conferences, which are enhancing your music education. Students who are only taking music lessons through school, for which there is no payment, are **NOT** eligible for this scholarship as it is designed to help cover your expenses. Instrument repair is **NOT** eligible under this program either.
- ✓ Complete the application **YOURSELF**. Instructions need to be followed or your application may be disqualified or your award lowered.
- ✓ Submit a CD of your selections. CD/mp3/mp4 formats are strongly preferred. **DO NOT SEND THIS VIA EMAIL.**
- ✓ Have your paid music teacher(s) and three (3) qualified people from your parish submit the confidential statements. No statements will be accepted via email.
- ✓ **ALL OF THE ABOVE MUST BE POSTMARKED by May 1, 2019** to be considered for this year's scholarships.

Application:

- ✚ Your application is the only way we get to know you. Fill it out completely!
- ✚ Please make sure your responses are dark enough to be visible when reproduced.
- ✚ If you require additional space for any question, use an 8½ by 11 sheet of paper. List the item number along with your continued response. Please make sure you include your name in the upper right-hand corner of such sheets.

- ✚ It is not necessary to send clippings, programs, copies of awards, etc. A properly filled out application will have all the necessary info the reviewers need to make their decisions.

Performance Submissions:

- ✚ Make sure your name appears on the outside of the CD.
- ✚ State your name, instrument, type and make of your instrument before each musical performance selection. If you are a vocalist, please state so.
- ✚ State the name of each song before the selection played. They should be played in the order listed on your application.
- ✚ You are expected to perform **four** (4) selections:
 - **Two** (2) songs from a NUC Publication - PNCC HYMNAL, Vol. 1, Vol.2, Vol.3, Advent and Nativity, or Spiewnik. Ask your Organist or Priest for help! For those of you who do not have access to a PNCC publication, songs are available on the website: nucmusicscholarship.weebly.com. Two of each difficulty level- easy, medium, and difficult will be available for your use. Play the songs as written - do not make up your own arrangement.
 - **One** (1) religious song that can be from an NUC publication above OR from another source (Amazing Grace, Blessed Assurance, etc.) Any song that may be played during the Mass is acceptable. This includes service songs such as the Gloria, Sanctus, Lamb of God, etc.
 - **One** (1) of the above songs must be played on the instrument you use when you play at church. For example, if you play the church organ, one song must be played on that organ.
 - **One** (1) song of your own selection. Most applicants choose something they are currently working on with a music teacher for a recital or for a class performance.
 - If someone else is accompanying you, please state his/her name and the instrument he/she is using. This is very helpful for vocalists applying for scholarships.

- **Do not submit more than the required four selections.** If you do, only the first four will be reproduced for the reviewers.
- ✚ As you are considering what selections to choose, take into account that the religious portion is equally important as your secular selection. After all, this is a CHURCH scholarship program.

Confidential Statements:

- ✚ Music Teacher(s) statements. This should be from your private instructor. It is recommended that you have your music teacher sign and seal your review at one of your music lessons and hand it to you to be mailed in. This will insure the timely receiving of their recommendation and will not jeopardize your potential scholarship!
- ✚ Three from your parish:
 - Pastor, Assistant Pastor, Administrator, Deacon, Organist, Choir Director, Choir Member, Sunday School Teacher, Youth Leader, or Parish Committee Member
 - Choose the three (3) you feel can **best** attest to your participation in the Music Ministry of your parish and your participation in the life of your parish.
 - Try to avoid using family members to evaluate you.
 - An applicant should NOT review another applicant UNLESS he is the music teacher of that applicant.
 - All statements should be sent directly to the Music Scholarship Committee from the evaluators. **AGAIN THE DEADLINE - POSTMARKED BY MAY 1, 2019.**
 - It is YOUR responsibility to follow up with the people you ask to review you to make sure they have submitted their forms to the Music Scholarship Committee.
- ✚ All confidential statements should be mailed separately and should not be included with your application.

Notice of acceptance or rejection will be sent out to the applicants after the reviewers meet. Official announcement is made at the NUC General Convention/Workshop to be held in the summer of the odd-numbered years, at the National Youth Convocation on even-numbered years and/or through the PNCC Publication - God's Field.
